What makes the archetypes more significant than just being descriptive, however, is that they are models, there is a deep significance to each archetype. They represent a certain personality, they imply certain traits and characteristics of a person. Jung said that a person in whom intuition was dominant, an intuitive type, acted not on the basis of rational judgment but on sheer intensity of perception. In the extraverted attitude, this function (intuition) is wholly directed to external objects. That means that an extrovert aims his ability of insight outward, instead of a type of inner reflection, the extrovert probably thinks more about other people and the significant aspects of them and how these aspects relate to themselves. It is difficult to grasp the nature of how this process works, because it is unconscious.
