Their stories are as compelling today as they were over sixty years ago at the height of World War II. Yet three times the Mosquito project was deleted from Britains future military plans, only to fight its way into the air and turn in performance figures that left fellow aircraft behind and its critics dumbfounded. Altogether, 7,781 examples of the Wooden Wonder would be built in no less than forty-three versions. Bomber, day fighter, night fighter, pathfinder, attack aircraft, trainer, reconnaissance aircraft the Mosquito did it all.
